CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer: This course is specialized training for individuals who have a job related “duty to respond” to emergencies. Topics covered include basic anatomy, how to recognize and provide care in respiratory and cardiac emergencies for adult, children and infants with special emphasis on two-rescuer-CPR, the use of a resuscitation mask and a bag-valve-mask. Techniques for preventing disease transmission and special rescue situations are included. Upon completion of the course requirements the participant will be issued a CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer certificate valid for 1 year. **No Refunds or Transfers**

Must bring pocket mask if doing Professional CPR/AED. Certificates issued for CPR are valid for 1 year and 3 years for First Aid. **No Refunds or Transfers**
